#### Why Story?

- God did it!
- Stories are universal
- Stories build trust
- Stories reinforce connections
- Create empathy
- Help us see God
- Produce cheerleaders

#### Why People Don't Share Stories

- 1. Don't know how to find the stories from their life.
- 2.Don't recognize opportunities to share.
- 3. Don't know how to put the stories into words.

#### Defining Story

Recounts a true story from your own life, focusing on a particular event, moment, or topic, that has taught you something useful.

#### Defining A Worthy Story

Recounts a true story from your own life, focusing on a particular event, moment, or topic, that has taught you something useful that you can also use to serve the needs of someone else.

#### If You Choose To Participate

Recounts a true story from YOUR OWN LIFE, focusing on a particular event, moment, or topic, that has TAUGHT YOU SOMETHING useful that you can also use to SERVE OTHERS.

#### Story Mining

- A deliberate process.
- Build a library of stories from your life.
- Access your stories.
- To serve others.

Set aside 20-30 minutes.

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- Start writing, Just a sentence or two at most.

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- Put your stories into categories.

#### **Story Categories**

- Stories that help people know you (R)
- Where you learned about yourself (L)
- Gave you hope (H)
   About making decisions (D)
- Examples of overcoming (O)
- Dealing with emotions (E)
- Planning for the future (F)
- Show God (G)
