
Our vision is to invigorate communities by freeing people affected by incarceration or addiction



David Garrison defines a church planting movement as "A rapid and exponential increase of indigenous churches planting churches within a given people group or population segment."










The Freedom Initiative Program is a two-to-three-year ministry training process, where leaders work through emotional and spiritual healing, theological training, and ministry apprenticeship

The 4 Phases of the Program:

- 1. Candidate: Healing and Discovery Phase
- 2. Student: Trained and Equipped for Christian Ministry
- 3. Apprentice: Empowered to Lead
- 4. Church Leader/Planter (after graduation)

- 6. Multiplied workforce inside & out



Hands-on church leadership




