Pre-Presentation

1. Identify volunteer opportunities/ministry needs

For example:

- Join the Prayer Team. Each week prayer requests will be emailed to you.
- Donate Verse Mapping Bibles at \$30 per Bible (website link to purchase Bibles, ship to: Ministry Name, Address, City, State, Zip Code).
- **Donate New underwear and socks** (Med, large, XL links to purchase shipping/delivery address).
- **Teach an anger management class** on Wednesdays, at the ministry, from 7:00-8:00 pm.
- Serve meals at Family Day Event at ministry site. The first Saturday of the month is from 11:00 am to 2:00 pm. Serve one or more Saturdays.



8. Create your presentation script

Write your presentation script. Your name, name of organization/ministry, description of ministry, story of how "the ministry makes a difference," identify ways the audience can make a difference (volunteer/support).



Through our residential faith-based programs, we serve men in your community released from incarceration helping them to repair their lives and restore their families.

9. Practice your presentation

Practice your presentation so you can be comfortable, clear and passionate about the ministry and opportunities to "make a difference."

10. Provide promotional materials/video to church/leader

11. Be early and test video

Be early so you can test the video and know when you will give your presentation.

12. Give presentation

Show the video and share your scripted message. Stay within the agreed time limit.

13. Be available

After the service/class be available to meet with anyone interested in partnering with your ministry.

Post-Presentation

14. Send Thank You Note

Send Thank You note to church leader.

15. Follow up

Follow up with those who complete the online form or sign-up sheet. Thank them for their interest, answer any questions, and let them know their next step.
